  - e. Fund Name 0840 Township Assistance (\$65,000)
  - f. Fund Name Local Fund 21 (\$138,713)
- 4. Fire Chief Report:
  - a. Starting the year anew
  - b. Addressed present Personnel positions open
  - c. Writing SOGs (Standard Operating Guidelines), have not found anything in place
  - d. Station Updates are needed (most can be done in-house); i.e. ceiling tiles, new locker room
  - e. Chief Car purchased last year needs decals, lights, sirens, tools
  - f. Computers out of date and do not work; Trucks do not have computers
- 5. Trustee's Report
  - a. Center Township Logo and Seal Created and Established
  - b. Township Website centertwpboone.com

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- c. Township Assistance Application will be available to submit online; pdf version of standards and application
- d. New Office Software will be available in the next few weeks
- e. Township emails established, Casey will give the board access to their email accounts, encourages all to use these emails for all township business
- f. Bidding for cemeteries will be open at a public meeting on February 1st
- g. Building available for purchase at 320 N. East St. for \$280,000
- h. Fire Apparatus Purchase Proposal presented; Legal recommended putting a hold on the purchase for a timeline and that the board cannot move forward without the bid process
